BEHAVIOR PLAN

We have a card system as part of our classroom behavior plan. Each child has a pocket on a chart in the classroom. The pocket contains four cards which are green, blue, yellow and red. A student will get a verbal reminder before having to turn the first card. Students turn a card when a behavior is not appropriate. Each time a card is turned, the student loses five minutes of recess. During this time, they will need to write the reason they are staying in and what they need to do differently. If the student turns to red, the parents are notified. After a student has missed the required amount of recess time, the cards are turned back to green for a fresh start. Students who have turned their cards to red will receive a pink slip. If they receive three or more pink slips in one month, they will miss the class reward at the end of that month.
