* Oral Reading

Please listen to your child read every day. Your child will be bringing home a fluency passage each week. It is also important for you to continue reading to your child. This is a great way for your child to hear fluent reading.

* Accelerated Reader (A.R.)

If your child was in A. R. at the end of last year, I will be sitting down with him/her to set a goal for each trimester. At this time, it will primarily be an activity that your child will be doing at home. I give the students a chance to take an A. R. test whenever they are ready. A sheet will be sent back and forth from school to keep you posted on how your child is doing on the tests. I will also be sending home a note from Renaissance Learning which will explain how you can look up your child's AR scores.

* Math Facts
